### Academic Excellence

Our students have consistently demonstrated exceptional academic performance with a significant number achieving distinction in board examination.

Master. M. Mohammed Al Rayan secured 94% of marks in Class X Board Examination and hold the position of school topper. Out of 15 students 3 secured above 90% (M. Mohammed Al Rayan 94, Muhammed Fadil Sali 93 and Varada Prasad 91). Total 11 nos got Distinction and 4 First Class.

Innovative teaching methodologies including project based learning and technology integration to foster critical thinking and creativity have been adopted to achieve the goal. Extra classes for the children were also implemented with the guidance of our school management.

The school reopening ceremony for the academic year 2024-25 took place on 03-06-2024 with great enthusiasm and excitement. The management and staff made special efforts to welcome the students and create an inspiring atmosphere.

Opening of KG Section was on 05-06-2024.

The program aimed to motivate the students and set the tone for a productive and successful year ahead. The new students and staff were welcomed with sweets and gifts.

### Staff

School staffs are the people who work in a school to help students succeed. School staffs are expected to create a safe and inclusive learning environment for

students. This includes teachers and support staff. This academic year we have 20 teaching staff and 7 non-teaching staff.

### Teachers Training
